Old Business:

We need to transfer \$2,000.00 from the investment fund to the expense fund to ensure we can cover the bills if we do not sell any lots this month. Dennis moved to transfer \$2,000 from the investment to the expense fund, Gladys 2^{nd} the motion, motion passed to transfer the money.

The website is moving slowly but is moving ahead.

New Business:

In regards to the Whitehouse Attorney letter: Postiers would like to buy some of the cemetery property to have another access to their property located north-east of the cemetery. Some key points about the possible sale included Linnie stating we can not get rid of property in the name of development. The area of interest is the cemeteries next area of development. We are caretakers of what is already established by previous commissioners. We need to make the best use of our acquired land. Gladys moved to not sell any property, 2nd by Dennis, motion passed. The clerk was asked to write a letter to Whitehouse informing Postiers we are not interested in selling.

Discussion with the commissioners about the cost of a 2nd inurnment, marking of 2nd headstones or monuments or transfer of lot ownership. The commissioners made a resolution to help with the cost of the previous mentioned. The resolution would include a \$25.00 fee for a 2nd or 3rd inurnment, marking for additional monument or headstone or to transfer the ownership of a lot (paid for by the new owner). The lots can not be sold for more than the purchase price. It would take effect on January 1, 2011. Dennis moved to pass this resolution 2nd by Gladys motion passed.
